A Young Lifeguard's Road to Recovery

Meet Sam Jarmer

At 16, Sam Jarmer was forced to re-learn life, and the team at Children's Specialized Hospital helped and cheered him on every step of the way.

July 24, 2019 was a normal day at the beach for 16-year-old lifeguard, Sam Jarmer. No one expected Sam's summer would quickly take a turn after diving into the water to cool off. When taking the dive, Sam hit a hidden sandbar and suffered a severe spinal cord injury, leaving him paralyzed from the chest down.

After emergency surgery, Sam was transferred to Children's Specialized Hospital in New Brunswick for intense inpatient rehabilitation and therapy.

Upon arrival, Sam had limited mobility throughout his body. He was able to lift his arms slightly, but had lost function in his fingers, core, and lower limbs. He immediately met with Dr. Michele Fantasia, Director of the Spinal Cord Injury Program at Children's Specialized Hospital, who was hopeful after an initial evaluation. She confirmed that Sam's injury was incomplete, explaining that the spinal cord was still intact in several areas, rather than being completely severed. Sam had the feeling he needed in his extremities, but he just wasn't able to move them.

"I just remember feeling like this would be the place that would make it all better," said Sam's mom, Jessica. "This is where we were meant to be."

Sam began recreational, physical, and occupational therapies with a team of doctors, therapists and nurses. His team assisted and customized Sam's entire care plan; teaching him to regain independence by holding his drink better, brushing his teeth in a new way, and using his phone differently.

"Everyone at Children's really helped me when I was at one of the lowest points in my life with my injury," said Sam. "They just showed compassion in all of the love and support that they gave me."

Today, Sam is back home in Ocean Grove, continuing to work on regaining complete strength in his core and legs. His positive outlook and optimism guides him through outpatient therapy and rehabilitation, along with the tremendous support he has received from friends, family, and his community.

Sam's story is just one example of the innovative and life-changing care provided at Children's Specialized Hospital. In 2019, over 38,000 infants, children, and young adults with their own unique stories passed through our doors.

(in thousands of dollars)


